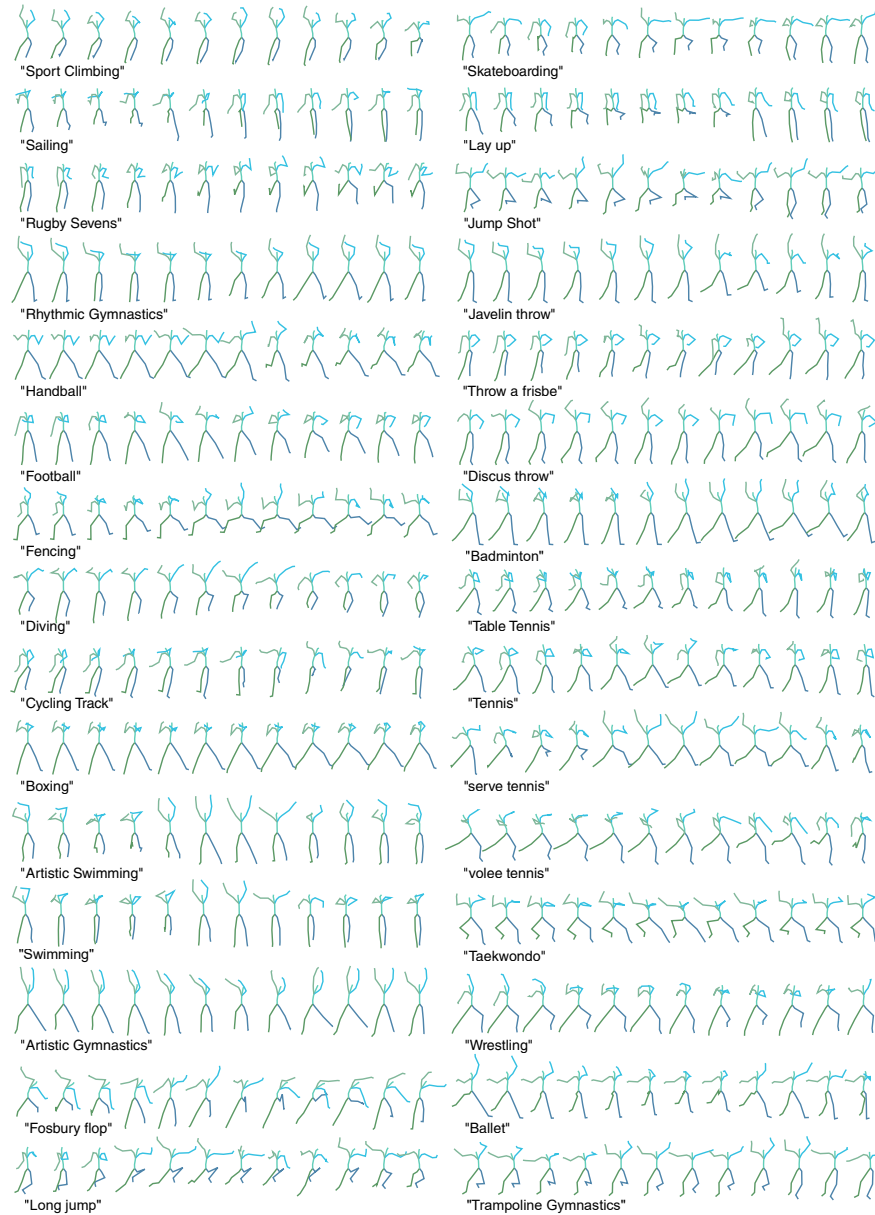


Fig. 1. Sport motions generated by MotionCLIP conditioned on the text beneath each row.
